Subject: CNS/ATM Seminar (Santiago, Chile, 11-15 December 1995)

In the pursuit of the CNS/ATM training programme, a seminar/workshop is being organized. This seminar will be held in Santiago, Chile, from 11 to 15 December 1995.

In the past, we were very fortunate to have the participation of Mr. D. Diez to cover issues such as ADS-SSR Data integration, Radar Data via satellite fixed links. Like previous seminar, the key elements of CNS/ATM will be covered but there will be also special emphasis on planning, institutional issues and cost benefit analysis. I have also learned that Spain has made a comprehensive cost benefit analysis concerning the transition to CNS/ATM. In line with the above, it would be most appreciated if Mr. Diez could, in addition to the topics on Radar Data Remoting and ADS-SSR integration, make a presentation to share with the lesser developed area the experiences of Spain in conducting such a study and the results achieved. This would be most useful in assisting less developed States in determining their transition strategy.

I hope that, as in the past, the Civil Aviation Authority of Spain will be able to participate and share their experience and knowledge with the States in the Caribbean and South American Regions. Your continued co-operation in the work of ICAO is most appreciated.
